Mission Statement: This is a Mentorship Program designed to provide the beginning Sun City student with the basics of understanding and playing the Ukulele.

This Program consists of Step-By Step “Group Lessons” arranged to provide the minimum standard requirements for basic Ukulele playing in a fun ‘jam’ setting. Further, each player will have the ability to advance at their ‘own speed’, as each class will be offered at every Mentorship Instruction week.

At the successful completion of this Program, the student should be able to play as well as up to 80% of all club Ukulele players and may be considered an ‘Advanced Beginner’ (Level 2).
