Return to sender, return to sender (*repeat once*)



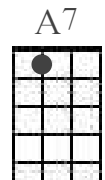

Bright and early next morning, he brought my letter back



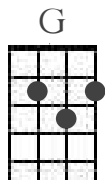

Return to sender, address unknown



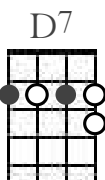

I write I'm sorry but my letter keeps coming back



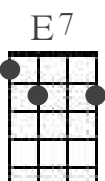
