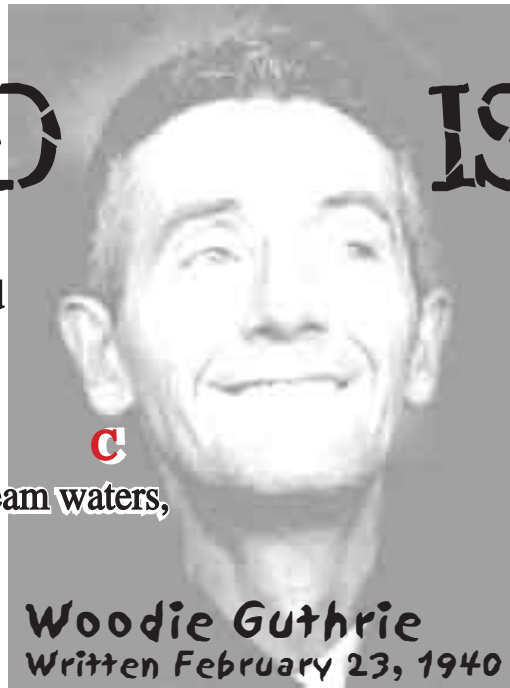


THIS LAND

IS YOUR LAND



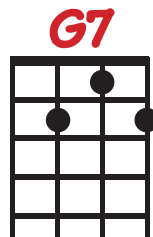
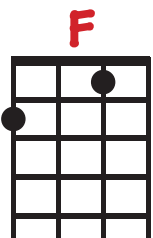
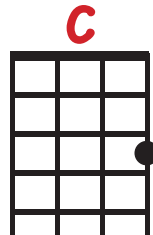
C F C
