

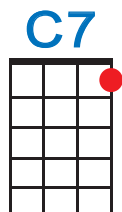
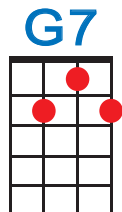
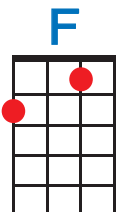
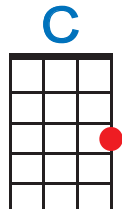
Bye Bye Love
