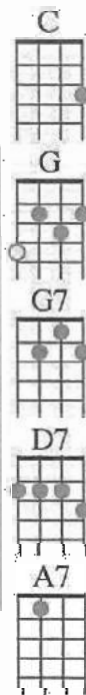

Plane Crash Kills 3 Rock 'n' Roll Idols

MARION CITY, Iowa (AP)—Three rock 'n' roll singing idols whose records and appearances drew millions of fans a night, were killed early yesterday in a wild, snow-swept Iowa field. The four planes were carrying the idols and their fans, while another plane fell out of sight soon after the Marion City airport.

This well known tune first recorded by The Crickets and later covered by Linda Ronstadt was also the first song recorded by The Quarrymen, the skiffle group that subsequently became The Beatles. The song came about after Holly, Allison and Crickets bandmate Sonny Curtis went to see the John Wayne film *The Searchers* in June of 1956. Wayne's oft repeated catchphrase, "that'll be the day" inspired the young musicians to write the song.
