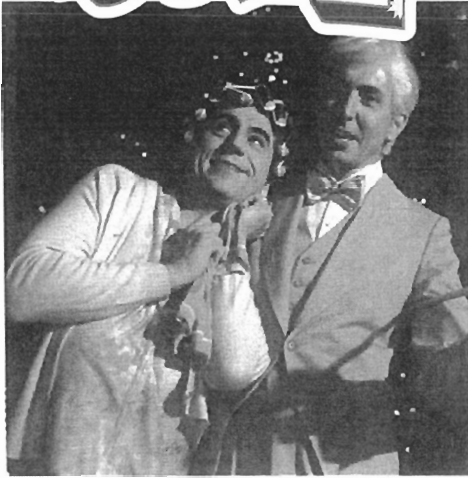
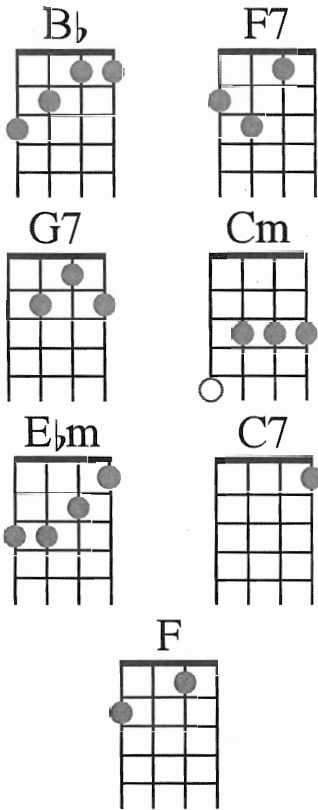


GALAXY SONG
