

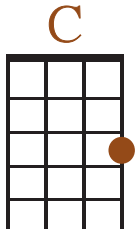

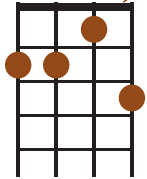

Am And I sure ain't fixin' to start in now. **Em**

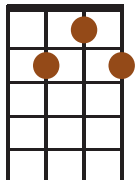

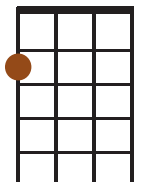

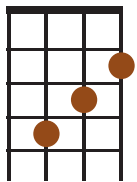
