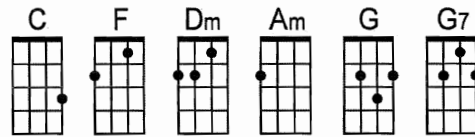
C Dm Am G C

F C

F G G7 C
Love has a nasty habit of disappearing overnight



C Dm Am G C
You're thinking of me, the same old way
C Dm Am G C
You were above me, but not today
C Dm C F G C
The only dif-frence is you're down there
C Dm F C F C F C F C
I'm looking through you, and you're nowhere

Back to Bridge

Repeat 1st Verse, then end with:

C F C F
Yeah, baby, you've changed
C F C F
Ah, baby you've changed
C F C F
Yeah, I'm looking through you ...



Rubber Soul was the sixth studio album by The Beatles, released in December 1965. Produced by George Martin, Rubber Soul was recorded in just over four weeks to make the Christmas market. The album attained widespread critical and commercial success, with reviewers taking note of The Beatles' developing musical vision. In 2012, Rubber Soul was voted 5th on Rolling Stone magazine's list of the "500 Greatest Albums of All Time".
