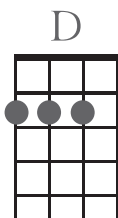
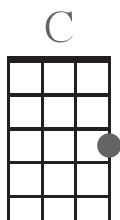
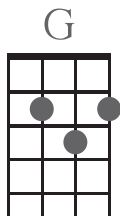


# Keep On the Sunny Side
