

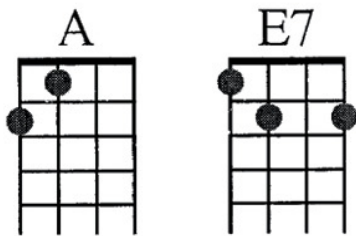
THE DAVE CLARK FIVE OVER AND OVER

In the three short years, they had eight top ten records between 1964 and 1967, 15 albums in the United States, and more appearances on the Ed Sullivan show than any other band.
