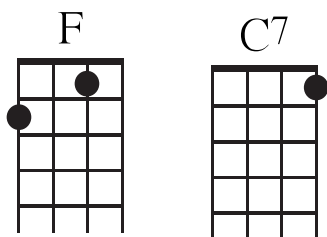


THE YELLOW ROSE OF TEXAS
