

Blueberry Hill

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4/4 time. Each beat is played as a triplet. Here is one example of a 4-beat measure, using the thumb for the down stroke, index finger for the up stroke:

↓↑↑ ↓↑↑ ↓↑↑ ↓↑↑

Each chord symbol = 4 beats, except where hyphenated and highlighted. Those chords = 2 beats each.

INTRO: **F - Bb** **F - F7**
Bb Bb F F
