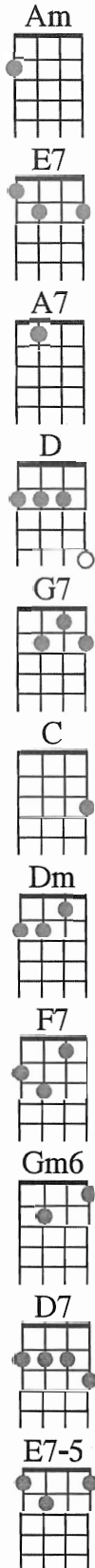


BROTHER, CAN YOU SPARE A DIME? ⁴²⁷
