2. Their horns were black and shiny and their hot breath he could feel,

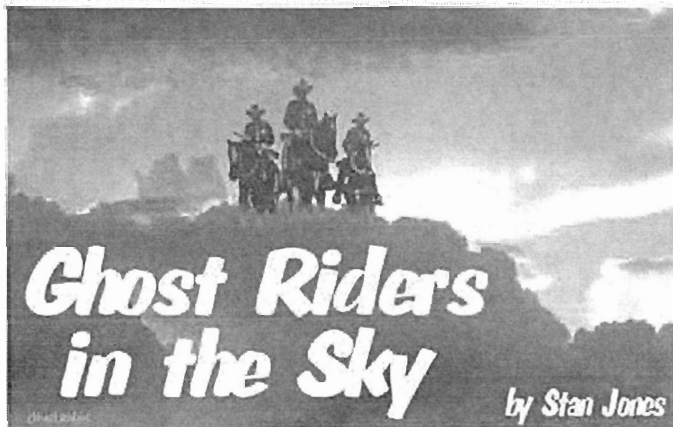

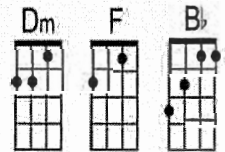
