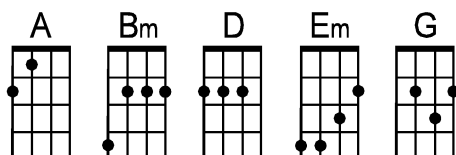
Bm A D
