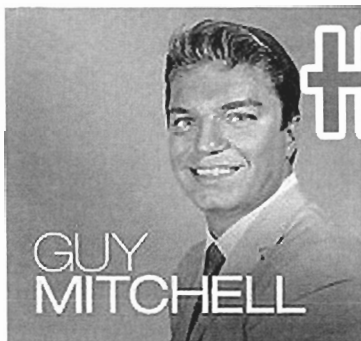

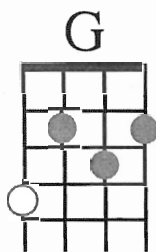

You came back, but never meant to stay

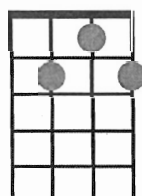

I waited but: you must have lost your way

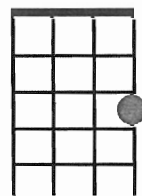
