I thought I'd be more in my 34th year

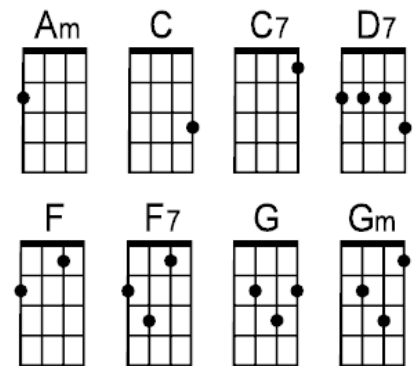
Am F7 Am F7
