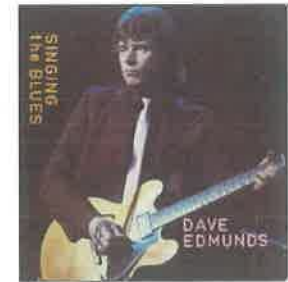
Well, I [C]never felt more like [F]singin' the blues
