

Walking After Midnight

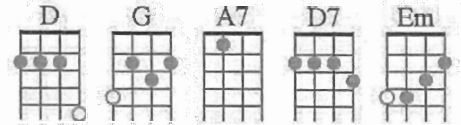

I'm always walking, after midnight, searching for you.

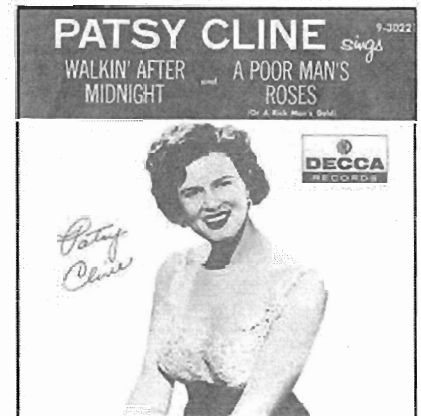
BRIDGE:
