You can do whatever you feel

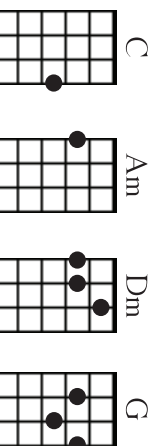
