Intro: Gx2, Em7x2, Amx2, D7x2 (twice)

Verse 1:

Blue [G] moon [Em7] [Am], You saw me [D7] standing a[G]-lone [Em7] [Am]

Without a [D7] song in my [G] heart [Em7] [Am]

Without a [D7] love of my [G] own [Em7] [Am] [D7]

Verse 2:
